Sustaining First Light Throughout the Year

First Light is sustained by (a) our own fund raising efforts, (b) support from the community, which comes in the form of volunteer services, in-kind donations and individual or group contributions, (c) grants from community and civic foundations or government agencies. All of these channels serve to sustain our agency. We also have an endowment fund directed at long term sustainability of the agency.

We are very proud of the portion of our income which comes as donations from individuals, churches, civic groups. Furthermore, First Light raises a huge percentage of its budget through our own fundraising efforts—the largest of which is our Gala, and also includes our Holiday Lights program, sales of beaded crosses and items in the Art Shop and responses to newsletters.

In fiscal year 2007:

25% of our income came from our own fundraising special events

14% came from individual donations

12% came from churches or civic groups

6% came from First Light programs such as beaded cross, art and t-shirt

Now that the new fiscal year is upon us, we would like to ask folks to consider making contributions on a monthly or quarterly basis, which would perhaps, more evenly distribute income throughout the year. Summertime is, historically, a SLOW time for donations.

IF ---- you are already a donor:

......we would like to challenge you to increase your giving level by at least 10% this year.

Our operating budget continues to increase as we have expanded our programs and services to include permanent supportive housing. Moreover, the economy is dictating that costs for power, water, food, supplies, are increasing.

Whatever you can do to partner with us to maintain the same standard of programs and services to this population of women with such deep and significant needs will be greatly appreciated! Thanks for being a part of First Light!!

The phrase - "one woman, one day at a time" repeats in my mind over and over as I reflect about our work here at First Light. It has become a mantra for me. And I use that phrase in grant applications, requests for contributions and thank you notes a lot. If you've read the ancient mystics you will recall the story about a rock in the forest. One raindrop does not make much difference as it plops onto the rock. But, over time, after hundreds and thousands of raindrops splashing upon the stone, a deepening in the hard surface will begin to occur, and the stone will develop a cuplike impression, which then can hold a small pool of water. You pragmatics can call it erosion if you like. It takes ALL those raindrops, one at a time, to wash away the outer surface and deepen an impression into the stone. A more poetic view allows one to make the parallel: One must have faith that each small gesture, every understanding smile, every group therapy session, every bus token given, every safe night's sleep, every load of

laundry washed, each donation, each plate handed from a volunteer over the counter to a guest in the Dining Room...makes a difference for one woman, one day at a time. It takes all of these First Light "raindrops" to make a loving impression which, hopefully, will carve out a greater capacity for a woman's self preservation and her ability to love herself and others. May time spent here help each woman to move on with her life blessed with a new strength and a deeper sense of hope for the future. It happens....one raindrop, one woman, one day at a time.

It is so humbling to hear the stories of our guests and, likewise, to witness what our wonderful volunteers do to care for the homeless women and children we serve. I thought it would be a good thing to share with you just why some people are First Light volunteers or why our donors contribute. So we've started this new column. Thanks to Jenny B. Nikoli for interviewing these special friends of FL!! D.B.E.

Judy Smith

Judy Smith is a volunteer in residence at Villa Glen, living in the same apartment complex with eight women who began to regain their footing in life at First Light and are now living semi-in-dependently in the Bessemer HUD Permanent Housing Program. Judy regularly offers the women rides to-and-from the bus stop, the grocery store, the bank, and even their jobs. Her interaction with them is often varied and depends on what they need; she recently took one of them to the emergency room and often picks one of them up from work when her 11 p.m. shift is over. She recently helped organize a pizza-dinner-and-movie-night for them, and wants to host a picnic for them this summer.

When asked why she chooses to help them, often sacrificing her own comfort and time, she replied, "I don't do this to make myself feel good. I serve because I have been saved to serve, and not for any reason tangible or intangible in this life or the one to come."

Judy likens these eight women to butterflies, beginning their journeys at First Light as caterpillars, close to the ground, hungry, and motivated by their needs. First Light offered them shelter, security and a place where they can grow strong enough to one day spread their wings and fly in beautiful freedom.

Looking back on my eighteen years as liaison for Our Lady of Sorrows, I realize my time with First Light has made me far more sensitive to the terrible effects that poverty, rejection, violence, and homelessness have on so many wonderful women in our community. I have become sensitive to my personal spending habits and means of living. I no longer spend as much on trivialities, and have therefore increased giving to those in need. I now see homeless women as human beings with normal human needs, and most poignantly, as my sisters and as daughters of God. This has truly been a labor of love, and my experience has taken me beyond a fear of the unknown. I can't help but feel empathy for the needs of these terribly abused women.

Not only am I motivated by the residents at First Light, but also by relationships I built with the staff and volunteers from my church, who willingly prepare and purchase food and other supplies, who donate their time and energy cheerfully. Around my church, some know me as "the First Light lady" or "the shelter lady," and perhaps hand me a ten dollar bill or leave a bag of toiletries on my doorstep. It is moments such as these and people I've met through my time with First Light that give me cause to reflect on the gifts which the Almighty God has bestowed upon me and allowed me to share with others. I am profoundly grateful for all these people: my fellow church volunteers, the First Light staff, and the women of First Light. Indeed, I am blessed to be a part of this ministry.

Chandra gets her GED!!!!

Chandra (pronounced Shawn-dra) is a First Light 4th floor permanent resident. She came to Birmingham from India several years ago. A tragic car wreck left her seriously injured and suddenly without resources or means to support herself. Back home she had the equivalent of a business degree; but now she found herself with brain injury and unable to function as she always had. Coming to First Light was an important step in her attempt to reclaim her life.

Staff at FL encouraged Chandra to enroll in the GED program offered by Jefferson State Community College. Over the course of the past year and a half, Chandra has gradually made her way through the Jeff State program - with lots of support from teachers and friends. The language barriers and other issues made it slow going for awhile.

On May 29th Chandraprabha Ghagare achieved her goal. She not only graduated from the GED program, but gained membership in the National Adult Education Honor Society. Moreover, she was one of eight students asked to say a few words to those in attendance at the graduation ceremony. Longtime volunteer and soon to be Board member, Emma Taylor, and Deb Everson, Assistant Director, went to the graduation and were very proud of Chandra's accomplishments.

She thanked First Light and her teachers for supporting her. It was very clear that this class of 72 students has many touching stories of individuals who worked very hard to get through the curriculum. It was also very obvious how deep their appreciation was to the Jeff State GED faculty and staff.

We are so very proud of Chandra and know she will continue to pursue her education and regain that sense of accomplishment she knew back home in India.
