"The women have a great spirit and they are amazingly productive. Many of the women asked for sewing kits, but I had given out the last one earlier in the evening. Yet, that did not stop them. The women gathered in a circle-some sitting, some standing- and shared the sewing kit while doing hair and talking at the same time. It sort of reminded me of Girl Scouts and I thank them for that memory."

No one deserves to be homeless.



## First Light Facts

### FY 2005 July 2004—June 2005

- 1,346 homeless women and children were served in the emergency shelter and in the emergency overflow shelter. (unduplicated)
- 15,001 nights of shelter were provided.
- 632 mental health assessments were conducted
- Compared to FY 2004, homeless recidivism at First Light was reduced by 48.8%. (A decrease from 129 returns in FY 2004 to 63 returns in FY 2005.)
- First Light was blessed with the dedication of more than 1,500 volunteers working over 7,500 hours in FY 2005.
- Since First Light opened its doors in May 2000, the number of guests served annually at First Light has more than tripled.
