**910 women and children were served** with emergency shelter and essential services at First Light, for a total of 7,726 bed nights.

**110** group sessions were conducted in the Project Healthy Minds program:

- ▼ 123 women attended Art Therapy
- ▼ 152 women attended Movie Therapy
- ▼ 148 women attended Group Therapy
- ▼ 223 women attended Life Skills sessions

Volunteers led bible study, prayer services or communion three to five times each week for guests who desired to participate.

Community volunteers and local universities provided education classes, health screenings, holiday parties, haircuts, manicures, fun movie nights and other experiences for guests throughout the year.

## More than 10,000 volunteer hours were recorded!

Of those who left First Light during the 2012-2013 period:

- ▼ 100 went to permanent housing
- ▼ 54 went to transitional housing
- 20 to a treatment facility
- ▼ 8 to hospital for psychiatric treatment
- ▼ 10 to hospital for medical treatment
- ▼ 3 to a domestic violence shelter
- ♥ 88 to another area shelter
- ♥ 4 to a group home or boarding home
